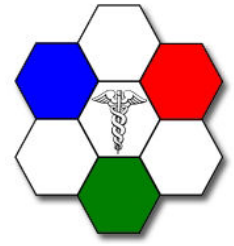




Beehive Solutions 1st Annual Charity Golf Day In aid of the Circulation Foundation. 8th October 2010,
